LEISCESTER SQUARE RESERVE PROPOSED PARK UPGRADE 2021

As part of the endorsed Gowanbrae Open Space Plan (2016-2021), the Reserve at Leiscester Square in Tullarmarine will be upgraded.

This park upgrade proposes a formalised concrete path from north to south through the park with a fenced playground centrally located.

The playground proposes a small play structure with roof, slide, climbing and other playful elements as well as swings, seating and nature play elements such as rocks, logs and steppers.

Extended garden beds will increase animal habitat, biodiversity and provide shade and amenity.

These elements will activate the space and take advantage of the natural shade from the surrounding mature and proposed trees, and provide a resting place or an area to play on the journey to or from home for the local community.


