



Imagine Moreland – what have we done and where are we now?

In May and June, our community panel of 44 randomly selected Moreland residents, took part in 6 online conversations. In each conversation the panel discussed a topic question. The panel read information, heard from expert presenters and provided feedback to help answer each of the 6 questions.

The conversations informed the Council Plan (which includes the Municipal Public Health and Wellbeing Plan), 10-year Asset Plan and 10-year Financial Plan.

Topic questions

Conversation 1 : Neighbourhoods

What key categories should Council prioritise when making decisions for investing in neighbourhoods to meet current and future needs of our community?



Conversation 3: Economy and the arts

How can Council best support local businesses and creative industries?



Conversation 5: Getting around

How can Council support more people to use sustainable modes of transport (walk, cycle, public transport) while also providing parking to people who need it?



Conversation 2: Health and equity

What can Council do to best address social and economic inequality in Moreland over the next few years?



Conversation 4: Governance and democracy

What actions would increase the community's trust in Council?

AND

What innovative ways could Council and community work together to deliver projects?



Conversation 6: Climate and waste

How can Council work with the community to increase local capacity for urgent climate action, and improve community resilience.



AND

How can Council work with the community (residents and business)

to reduce the amount of waste going to landfill?

What's next?

The Council Plan and 10-year Financial Plan have been drafted based on input from the community panel. Both plans are available for viewing and feedback from **Monday 30 August until Monday 20 September**. The 10-year Asset Plan will be on public exhibition in 2022.
