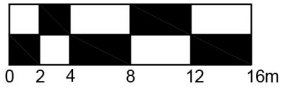

## Proposed Park Upgrades Include:

1. Playground upgrade with inclusive play elements, recycled materials, additional seating (formal and informal), nature play, trees for more shade and new equipment.
2. New 5 x 8 Shelter with communal table for sharing garden produce, small workshops and gatherings.
3. Power outlet for events stationed at the south end of the shelter.
4. Concrete entry ramp to community garden from Reynard Street
5. Entry arbour with sign to community garden
6. Concrete paving from Neighbourhood house to new BBQ and Shelter area.
7. Compacted gravel paving for outdoor cafe area and surrounding raised garden beds for easier wheelchair access
8. New Double Plate, wheelchair accessible BBQ
9. Replacement of degraded or damaged furniture throughout the park.
10. New sink and bubbler on north side of toilet building near BBQ.
11. New Tool shed on SW side of toilet building.
12. First Nations mural art on south side of Toilet building wall.
13. Permeable fencing between Reynard St Neighbourhood House and Park
14. Upgraded mulch bays and composting facilities.
15. Barrier fencing kerb side at path exits to Reynard Street.

## Proposed Playground Items Include:

- a. Refurbished swing sets with new scuff pads.
- b. Refurbished pommel see-saw and scuff pads.
- c. New edging including recycled tyres, logs and rocks for stepping and informal seating and new seats with arm rests also.
- d. New Pendulum Basket Swing
- e. Wheelchair accessible carousel
- f. New play Unit with some shade roofing, slides, monkey bars, binoculars and climbing elements.
- g. New, challenging, rope, climbing structure.
- h. Refurbished and relocated spring rockers.
- i. New picnic table in the playground.
- j. Canopy tree planting within and surrounding the playground for shade and amenity.
- k. Additional planting in the large garden bed to the West of the playground.

## Robinson Reserve Park Upgrade Draft Landscape Concept Plan

Residents and the wider community were invited to submit feedback on the draft concept plan prior to 5/2/2023. Community feedback was generally positive and only minor changes have been made for safety and maintenance purposes. Council would like to thank the Community for their feedback.
