Louisa Street Pop-up Footpaths

Line marking and speedhump installation

Council is preparing to improve the street design for Louisa Street between Victoria Street and Munro Street. We want to make Louise Street safer, more accessible, and easier to walk around.

Why are we doing pop-up footpaths?

Louisa Street does not currently have any footpaths. Council is installing pop-up (temporary) footpaths along both sides of the street, to improve safety and accessibility. The pop-up will allow us to test some ideas for the permanent street design and see how they work for the community.

We are working with local artists to add colourful eyecatching designs to this pop-up installation.

The permanent upgrades for Louisa Street will be delivered in stages, to align with the broader development plan for Coburg Central and associated infrastructure renewal works.

Will there be traffic impacts?

Louisa St traffic will not be significantly impacted.

Slower traffic and stopping may be required on Louisa St during the line marking and speedhumps installation. The traffic controller will direct traffic using the stop-and-go sign.

Installation of the rubber speedhumps and will be done early in the morning to minimise disruption. Please follow the local traffic signs.

There will be no closure for the driveways of the carparks. The car parking area will not be affected.

Louisa Street, Coburg, between Victoria Street and Munro Street.

Type of works:

- Between Monday, 31 July Friday, 4 August 2023
 - Line marking and Road Pavement installation (1 day)
 - Base coat for the footpath pavement and artwork by artists (3-5 days)
- Tuesday, 8 August 2023 Installation of planter boxes (3-4 days)
- Thursday, 10 August 2023 Installation of rubber speedhumps, bollards and traffic signs (1-2 days).
