Why are we doing pop-up footpaths?

Louisa Street does not currently have any footpaths. The pop-up (temporary) footpaths will improve safety and accessibility.

They will also allow us to test some ideas for the permanent street design and see how they work for the community.

The long-term permanent upgrades will be delivered in stages, to align with the broader development plan for Coburg Central and other infrastructure works.
