What is this strategy about?



We are working on a new transport strategy.



A **strategy** is a document that includes:

- a list of our goals
- how we are going to reach our goals.



This **transport strategy** will make it easier to get places by

- riding a bike
- driving
- walking
- and other ways to travel.



This is a **draft**. We will write a final version of the strategy in early 2024.

Why do we need a new transport strategy?



We are making this new strategy because a lot has changed over the last 4 years.



We've changed other Council strategies.



Climate change has gotten worse.



The COVID-19 pandemic has had lasting impacts.

Why is this a draft



This version of the strategy is a **draft**.



We will write a final version of the strategy in early 2024.



We will make changes to the final strategy based on community feedback.



Councillors will decide whether the strategy is finished in March 2024.

How we wrote this strategy



This year we asked lots of different people from Merri-bek about how they move around.



They told us how we could make it easier to move travel where they need to go.



This feedback helped us write our draft strategy.



We also used research and data about transport in Merri-bek.

How does this strategy work?



Our Draft Strategy is made up of **3** parts.

In the first part, we talk about our **vision and 6 values**. These are the things that are important for our transport system.

The second part **explains our transport system** and the 5 kinds of transport that we work on in Merri-bek.



The third part **explains our new Streets for People system**. This will help us pick streets for new transport projects.



There is also a separate **Action Plan**, which explains the transport projects we have planned for 2024-2025

Our values



Our Draft Strategy talks about **6 main values** for transport in Merribek.



We want to make sure that we build a **transport system** that is:

- 1. safe
- 2. accessible to everyone
- 3. good for well-being
- 4. environment friendly
- 5. pleasant to live with
- 6. inclusive and built together



We want our community to feel **safe** while they

- Walk
- Ride a bike
- Ride a scooter
- Drive
- Or catch a bus, train and tram



When something is **accessible**, everyone can use it. This might be

- a public transport
- a car
- a bike
- or a safe road to walk

We want to offer active and enjoyable ways to get around Merri- bek to help people be **healthy.**

We want to help the environment by helping people use **sustainable** transport such as

- walking
- riding bikes
- car share
- using public transport

We want Council to **include** everyone and work with our community to improve our transport system.









We want to create vibrant and welcoming spaces for people to come together.



This includes having access to

- shops
- services
- and community facilities.



We want to make sure everyone can

- get where they need to go
- easily use transport
- feel safe when they use our transport network
- feel welcome

Our networks



Our transport system is made up of lots of **networks**. A network is a way to get around your neighborhood.



There are **5 networks** we work on in Merri-bek. They are

- walking network
- bicycle network
- public transport network
- driving network
- how we plan to use land

We want to make these networks better. Some of the ways we will do that are

Walking network

- improving footpaths
- adding more road crossings
- adding seats, lights and trees
- helping kids walk and bike to school







Biking network

- build more bike paths
- improve the bike paths we already have
- make it easier to use scooters, tricycles, electric bikes and other wheeled transport
- add more bike parking



Public transport network

- help with the Level Crossing Removal Project in Brunswick
- work to improve our bus network
- work to make all our trams, trains and busses accessible
- work with the Victorian Government to connect the Upfield Train Line to the Craigieburn Train Line





Driving network

- have safer speed limits
- support electric vehicles
- support car share
- improve our roads
- support deliveries of freight to shops
- balance how we use our kerbside space (the space between the road and footpath or nature strip)




How we use land

- plan our projects so people can get to shops, schools, work, doctors and other places easier

It also helps us pick what kind of project is good for that street.



Streets for People helps us make a street better for all the people who use it.

The Action Plan is a list of actions that we will do over 2024-2025.



These projects will help us achieve our transport goals in the Draft Strategy.



Next year we will release another Action Plan for 2025-2030.
