




Council resolved to review its Food Systems Strategy in line with the new VicHealth Strategy 2023-33

Food System Strategy 2020-24 - Community impacts






- Food Leadership Action Group (FLAG) of community food leaders established 2022 to lead development of a Community Food Hub in the north of Merri-bek
- My Smart Garden education and capacity building program, winner 2023 Tidy City & Sustainability Education and Premier's Sustainability award,







Food System Strategy 2020-24 - Community impacts





- More than 300 Merri-bek households have collected 9 tonne of olives during the annual Olives to Oil Festival, 6 tonne in 2023 alone.
 Winner Merri-bek Community event of the year
- Delivered 3 local food networking and gardening events
- Council community grants invested in local community food groups and projects and provided letters of support for external grants

Council's role – stakeholder interviews



- Map / track and share the outcomes and benefits of Merri-bek's community food organisations, projects and initiatives
- Facilitate connection between local food community groups and projects, build relationships and partnerships to enhance outcomes and benefits
- Community grant funding and other project / seed funding is important / valued but lack of ongoing / operational funding a major issue



• Capacity builder- provide the community with knowledge, skills and tools to understand, measure and lead the actions

Food System Strategy actions still to be achieved



- Create Indigenous foods learning space
- Support and development of strategic food growing sites (Open Space masterplans, Neighbourhood House programs)
- Review Community Garden guidelines



- Consolidate food system network communication channels and establish resource hub
- Support for local food social enterprises in Council's procurement practices

Emerging needs and opportunities



- Council support for food justice building community resilience to food related impacts of climate change
- Upskill community organisations to measure their impact and contribution to the goals of the Food System Strategy.
- Identify more reliable and ongoing funding streams and support to access infrastructure
- Resourcing the community-led approach so that the drive and passion of community leaders is harnessed without leading to burn-out


Groups and organisations:
